Cancellation Policy and Camp Details

Cancellation and Transfer Policy

No refunds will be given for cancellations. If your child is unable to attend a week or day of camps for which they are registered, you will be charged the full amount and it will be considered a donation to the Center for Snake Conservation - My Nature Lab. If your child cannot attend, you can either:

- (1) Transfer your registration to a family member or friend of the appropriate age. Transfer requests must be submitted to info@mynaturelab.org and must be approved before a transfer is accepted. Only full week transfer requests will be considered for 4-Day Critter Camps- partial week transfer requests will not be evaluated. Restrictions may apply.
- (2) Request a donation receipt for the full amount of a canceled camp registration.

In the event that a program is canceled by My Nature Lab, registrants will receive a full refund. Transfer requests will incur a \$25 administrative fee.
