Payment, Cancellation, & Transfer Policy, Age Policy, and Participant Requirements

Payment, Cancellation, and Transfer Policy

Registration is available for the full year only.

A non-refundable deposit is due at registration: \$300 for 5 hour programs, \$180 deposit for 3 hour programs

Tuition & Payment Options

Half Day Programs:

- Deposit due at registration (applies directly toward total tuition for all payment options):
\$180
- Payment Plan (Standard Rate):
 - Total Tuition: \$1,439
 - \$180 deposit at registration plus four payments of \$314.75
- Pay-in-Full Discount (Best Value):
 - Total Tuition: \$1,326 (*Save \$113 instantly when paid in full*)

Full Day Programs:

- Deposit due at registration (applies directly toward total tuition for all payment options):
\$300
- Payment Plan (Standard Rate):
 - Total Tuition: \$2,398
 - \$300 deposit at registration plus four payments of \$524.50
- Pay-in-Full Discount (Best Value):
 - Total Tuition: \$2,208 (*Save \$190 instantly when paid in full*)

For late registration after the initial billing period, bills will be issued within three days of registration and will be due in two weeks or before the next session of the course, whichever

comes first. Bills will be prorated to reflect the number of sessions remaining in a program. Email info@mynaturelab.org to request information about setting up a payment plan if you require financial assistance.

Late payments will incur a \$50 fee. Students with unpaid balances at the start of their program will not be allowed to attend their program until all outstanding balances are paid. Students with unpaid balances may lose their spot in the program for which they are registered.

Cancellation Policy:

- All deposits are non-refundable.
- **No refunds will be given for cancellations.** If your child is unable to attend the program for which they are registered, you will be charged the full amount and you can either:
 - (1) Transfer your registration to a family member or friend of the appropriate age. Transfer requests must be submitted to info@mynaturelab.org and must be approved before a transfer is accepted. Restrictions may apply.
 - (2) Request a donation receipt to the Center for Snake Conservation - My Nature Lab for the full amount of a canceled registration or non-refundable deposit.Note: Once a program has started, no prorated refunds, transfers, or credits will be issued for remaining unattended sessions.

Age Policy

All students must meet the age requirements below (as of October 1, 2026). If students do not fall into these age categories and have not received written approval to register, their registration will be canceled minus a \$25 administrative fee.

Hatchlings: Ages 4-5 (rising Pre-K and Kindergarten; age as of October 1, 2026)

Budding Biologists: Ages 6-7 (1st and 2nd grade, age as of October 1, 2026)

Life Scientists: Ages 8-9 (3rd and 4th grade, age as of October 1, 2026)

Junior Biologists: Ages 10-11 (5th and 6th grade, age as of October 1, 2026)

Senior Biologists: Ages 12-13 (7th and 8th grade, age as of October 1, 2026)

Ecologists: Ages 14+ (High School, age as of October 1, 2026)

Participant Requirements

All participants must be fully potty trained, follow directions, and stay with the group at all times in the Lab and in the Field. Conditions in the field may be uncomfortable (tall grass, heat, cold,

water, long walks, etc.) and students must be prepared for these conditions and be able to stay with the group. Students must demonstrate respectful behavior towards other students, educators, property, Lab/wild animals, etc. at all times. Bullying and inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated. If your child does not meet all of these requirements, My Nature Lab reserves the right to withdraw your child from an individual lesson or the program without a refund.
